

MBA PROFESSIONAL TRACKS

The Monash MBA program consists of 10 core and 6 elective units. The elective units enable you to gain either a specialist or broadening educational experience. The objective is to allow you to tailor make your MBA program to suit your individual personal and professional career goals and aspirations.

To choose a professional track or a broadening educational experience you should

- Attend the following two MBA Career Management Workshops, which you participate in the Personal Skills Development (PSD) module of the Leadership program.
 - Introduction to Career Management (conducted during the PSD Module)
 - Explore your Professional Objectives (conducted early each semester)
- Discuss with the MBA Director or an academic advisor, elective options that fit with your personal and professional career goals.
- Explore the appropriate Monash University department websites to view unit outlines (brief descriptions) and timetabling information.

It should be understood that a *Professional Track* consists of completion of a minimum of four units in any one discipline. The name of the *Professional Track* will be notated, upon request, on a certificate issued by the MBA Programs along with a listing of the units that comprise that track.
